



# **Program Overview**

## **History and Purpose: JMHCP**

Improve the criminal justice system's response to adults with mental health disorders, co-occurring mental health and substance use disorders, and people with intellectual and developmental disabilities who may come into contact with the system.

- Established in FY 2006
- \$218.55 million awarded in grants
- FY24 awarded 24 JMHCP grants (12.7 million) & 6 YJMHCP grants (3.5 million)



## **History and Purpose: Connect & Protect**

Improve law enforcement and mental health collaboration in order to **improve responses to and outcomes for individuals with MHDs, co-occurring MHSUD's, and intellectual and developmental disabilities** who come into contact with law enforcement.

- Established in FY 2021
- \$56.25 million awarded in grants
- FY24 awarded 20 grants (10.5 million)



#### Deliverables



- Sustainability Plan plan at closeout for obtaining necessary support to sustain and continue the proposed collaboration at conclusion of federal support.

#### **BJA PPI TEAM**


Sets program goals and collects performance measures data to assess achievement of those goals. All BJA grantees collect and report performance data.


